About Life College



The internships introduce students to the real world of working at a job site.

- Paid or unpaid
- 3 hour shifts, 5 days per week.
- Soft Skills Focus: teamwork, self advocacy, active listening, conflict resolution, taking initiative, respect for supervision and other co-workers, and communications
- Hard Skills Focus: stocking, order fulfillment, inventory and clerical support, clerical, filing, and scanning

Life College will support the training provided by the employer's management and co-workers, certify the student in job accuracy and performance, and assist the employer in providing reasonable accommodations to enable student success.
